FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

- **Who is eligible to collect containers and cash them in?**
Everyone can collect eligible containers and cash them in at Stanley Road
- **Do I need a scheme ID?**
No, you don't need a scheme ID. A scheme ID means the funds will be deposited straight into your bank account. You can also just receive a cash refund.
- **Can crushed or damaged containers be accepted at Stanley Road?**
Yes, we will accept crushed cans, though we must be able to identify the container as an eligible container. Containers at Stanley Road are manually counted so the barcode does not need to be visible.
- **How many containers can I bring in for a refund?**
If you have more than 825 containers per person on board, you must show your photo ID. If you have more than 1500 containers you must complete a declaration declaring the containers have been obtained genuinely.
- **How can I donate containers to a community group or charity?**
If you don't know your chosen charity's scheme ID, you can ask us to look up for you.
- **Where can I buy Bulk bags for our community group/business's containers?**
Stanley Road Waste Facility have bulk bags you can buy then swap out to an empty one each time you come and drop off containers. (\$12 for the large bulk bags, \$2.50 for the small bags)
- **How can we advertise we are fundraising and accept containers?**
We can happily customise a free social media advertisement with your details for the Container Deposit Scheme.
- **How will I receive my refund at Stanley Road?**
Refund point operators can issue 10 cent refunds in various ways:
 - in cash
 - by EFT if the person/charity has a Containers for Change scheme ID
- **Why are milk and wine bottles not part of Containers for Change?**
The scope of eligible beverage in Western Australia is consistent with other schemes across Australia, where milk and wine bottles are not included. Eligible containers will be reviewed periodically and in conjunction with other states and territories.
- **Are there extra COVID-19 restrictions applicable with this scheme?**
There are no COVID 19 rules in regards to objects. All Refund and Collection Points should follow WA Government and Worksafe WA requirements and complete a risk assessment to ensure the safety of employees and customers. This will include ensuring appropriate disinfecting and cleaning of all equipment and items used as well as appropriate PPE to be worn. These requirements will be revised dependant on changes to WA's COVID 19 status and Government restrictions.

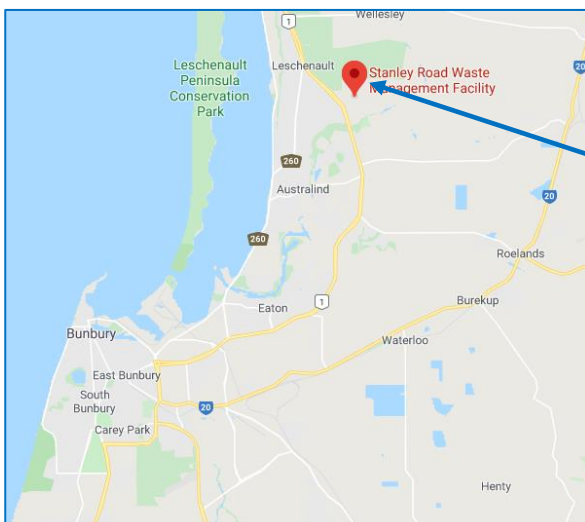
If you have **large quantities** of containers to be processed, Bunbury Harvey Regional Council will be offering services outside of these times giving businesses, clubs and groups the option to bring in containers when there is less traffic allowing efficient drop off of containers.

We encourage you to contact us to plan to come in before general traffic is allowed to enter at 9am.

We also encourage groups to apply for a Containers for Change Scheme ID which makes it even easier to return containers and receive refunds directly to your bank account.

When you drop off your containers why not bring out other items that need to be correctly disposed of!

The Recycling Station at Stanley Road Waste Management Facility can be used to correctly dispose of many recyclable items that cannot be recycled in your kerbside bins.

The following items are accepted free of charge at the Yellow Recycling Station.

- Plastic Bottle tops
- Bread tags
- Stationery
- Coffee Pods – Nescafe or Moccona
- Batteries
- Mobile Phones
- Oral Care
- Smoke Detectors
- Aerosols
- Printer Cartridges
- Soft Plastics
- Clothing and textiles
- X-rays
- Fluro globes and tubes

The transfer station at the Stanley Road Waste Management Facility accepts the following items for recycling and waste disposal:
